When arriving at the main train station:

The office is about 1.3 km from the train station. Leave the main entrance of the train station and turn left. Walk about 50m to Sophienblatt Strasse. Turn right into Sophienblatt Strasse and walk about 900m until you reach Berliner Platz (roundabout).

At Berliner Platz turn diagonally left and proceed to the pedestrian crossing. Cross the road to the right and keep going straight ahead until you reach the Alter Markt (Karstadt departmentstore).

As soon as you get to the market turn left and walk straight ahead to Küterstrasse. Go down the Küterstrasse to the first intersection (Faulstrasse). The entrance to our office is on the corner to the right.

By car

Follow the autobahn (A 215 or A 210) until it ends at the edge of town (if you take the B 76 leave it when you get to the A 215 autobahn taking the signs towards the center of town "Innenstadt"). Drive straight ahead down the Schützenwall and Knooper Weg until you reach Exerzierplatz (the Marktplatz is on the right). Turn right after Exerzierplatz. Turn left at the next set of lights into Rathaus Strasse and follow this. At the second set of lights get into the second lane from the left and enter Kehden Strasse on the other side of the intersection. Follow Kehdenstrasse until you reach Alter Markt and, keeping left, drive down Küterstrasse. Our office is located on the right at the next intersection (Faulstrasse).

There is a public car park directly opposite the building. You can reach the Jensendam parking building if you turn right at our office and go to the end of the short street and turn left at the end. The entrance to the parking building is immediately to the right.

By public transport

You can reach us by bus from the main train station in just a few minutes (lines 11, 81/82, 91, 501/502 or 900/901). At the main train station make you sure you take the bus from the same side of the street as the station. Get off the bus at the
